In line with the NSW Public Health (Covid-19 Safety) Order 2021 we have had to make some changes to our booking terms and conditions, conditions of entry, and use and operation of park facilities to ensure we remain compliant with the requirements and restrictions which apply to our premises. Please ensure you read and understand the updated information, and your obligations, before arriving at Great Aussie Holiday Park

Conditions of Entry

The following conditions of entry are applicable from Monday 11th October 2021.

- Any person aged 16 years or older, who has not been fully vaccinated for Covid-19, or cannot satisfactorily prove that they have been vaccinated for Covid-19, will not be permitted to enter Great Aussie Holiday Park property.
- All guests and visitors MUST check in on arrival at the park, using the Service NSW QR code displayed on the reception front door.
- Any person who has, or develops, respiratory symptoms or a fever (>37.5°C), even if symptoms are mild MUST:
 - Place themselves in isolation in their accommodation immediately
 - Advise staff
 - Contact the Health Department / Local Public Health Unit for further instructions
- Any person entering Great Aussie Holiday Park must comply with the current NSW Public Health (Covid-19 Safety) Order 2021 directions while on the premises. This includes but is not limited to:
 - Face masks must be worn in all indoor common areas
 - 1 person per 4m² in all communal areas
 - Maintaining 1.5m physical distancing
 - Gatherings must not exceed 30 people at any one time in open areas of the park.
